We collected 94kgs of rubbish! 100 bottles and 163 cans! We made the area safer for native animals and nicer for us to enjoy.

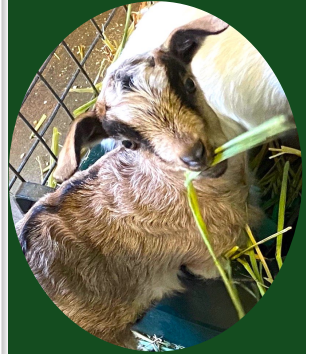

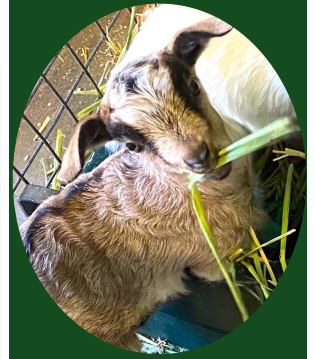
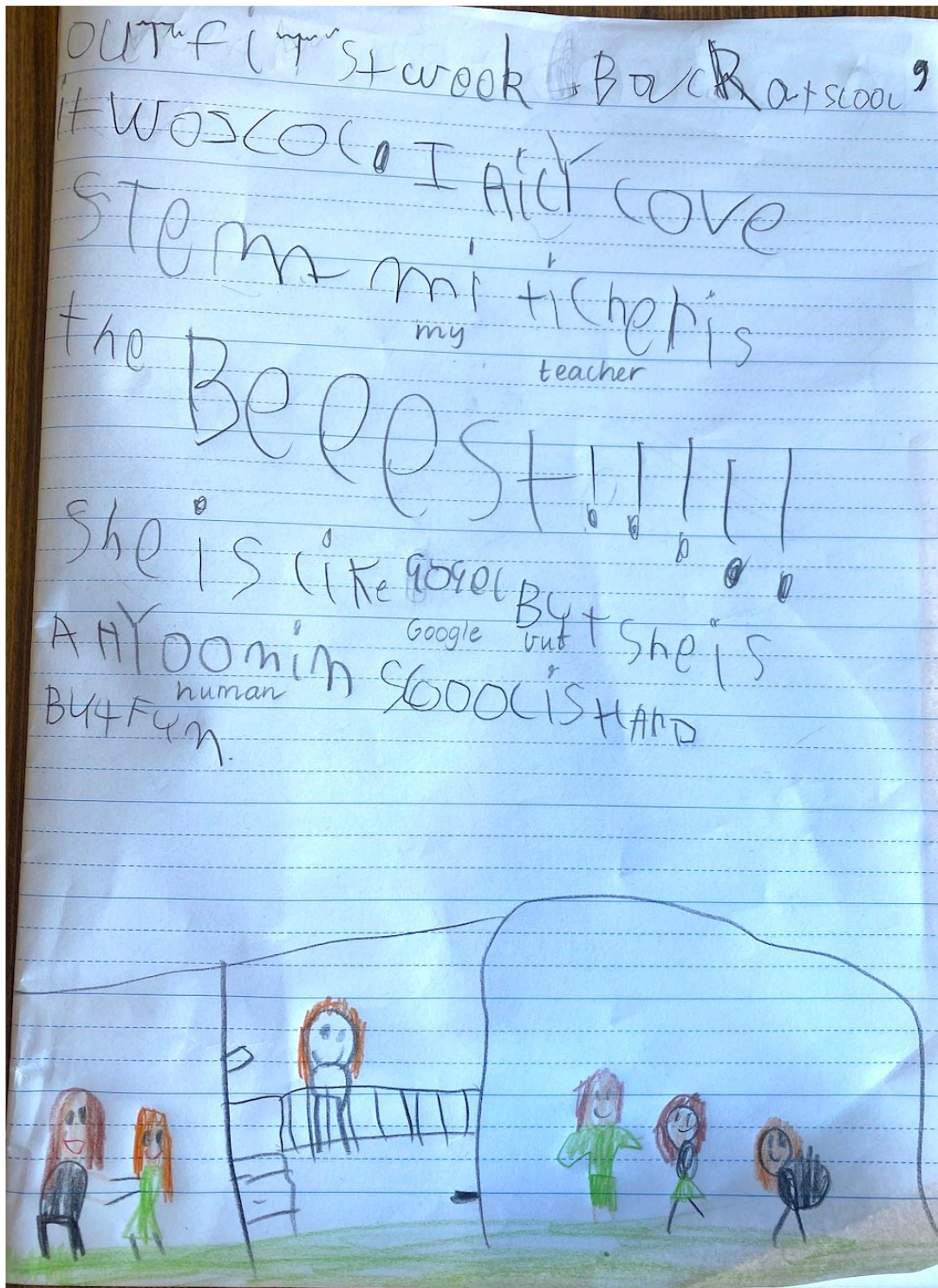
incursion about the levels of the Australian government and then some volunteers came to speak to us about what they do in the community for free!

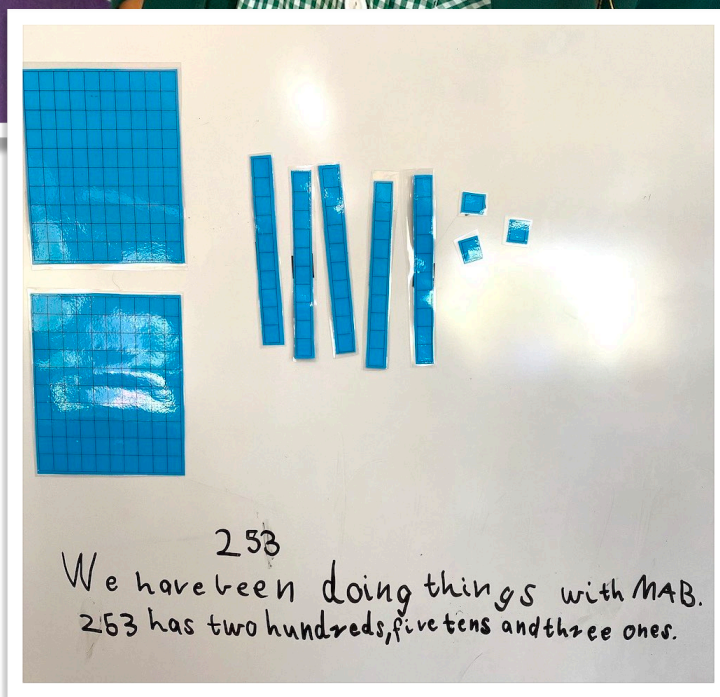

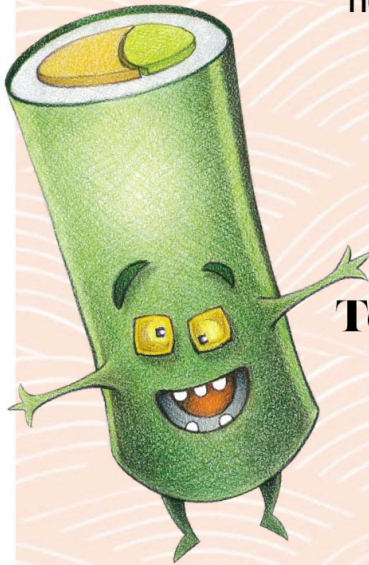

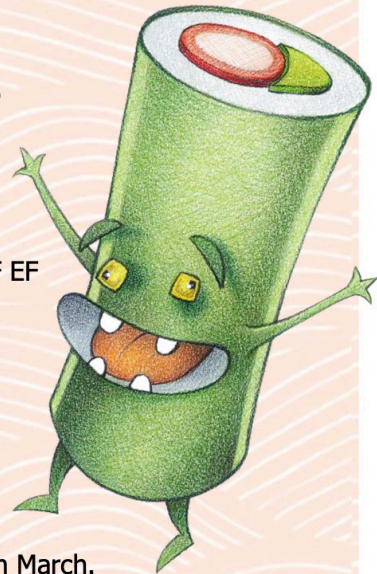
