

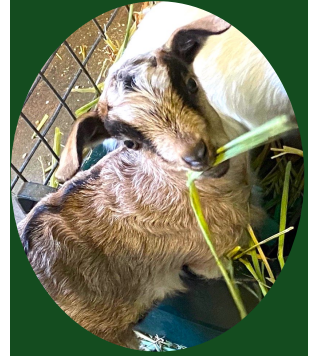

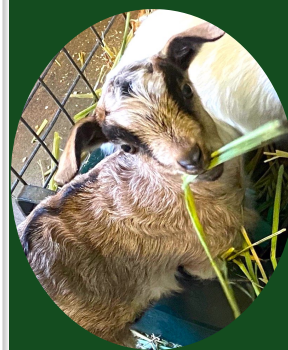
ANZAC Commemorative Service involving local school students. We are very proud of our relationship with the Seaford RSL and thank them for their ongoing support of our school.
