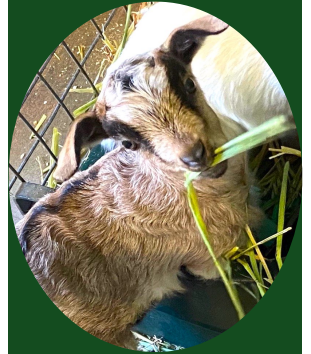
**It is amazing to think that we only have two weeks left until the end of term.**

**Over the past month we have been working through a number of staffing appointments and changes due to teachers taking leave during Semester 2 and an increase in Disability Inclusion Funding.** After

completing the process, we have been able to make some staffing changes and appointments to ensure the students have the best teachers and ES staff working with them at Carrum Primary School. In relation to teaching staff, there have been a couple of changes to be aware of. From next week Mis Scarola will be on leave for the remainder of the school year. I am very pleased to share that Miss Kathryn Kenner and Mrs Nuala Martin who have been working at the school for some time will be teaching the grade for the remainder of the year. Miss Kenner will teach the class on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday and Mrs Martin will teach the class on Tuesday and Friday. These changes have meant we have employed Mrs Gill Murphy

to work in the prep area on Tuesdays and Thursdays in an intervention role, Mrs Dudley will be moving into the 1/2 area to run intervention groups and teach in 1/2 A on Thursdays, while Mr Will Barnett who has been working in the 5/6 area this term will be working as a tutor in the 3/4 area. 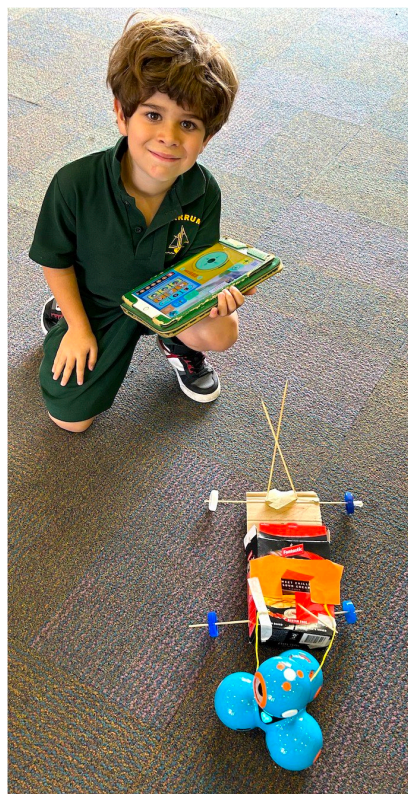
**Looking ahead to next week, Monday is a public holiday for the King's Birthday.**
