

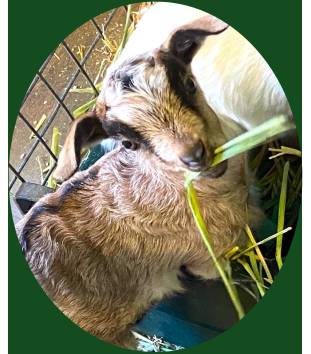

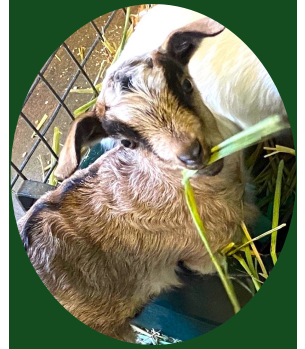
This term in 3/4 in Inquiry we are learning about 'feathers, furs and leaves'.

And that's all, bye!

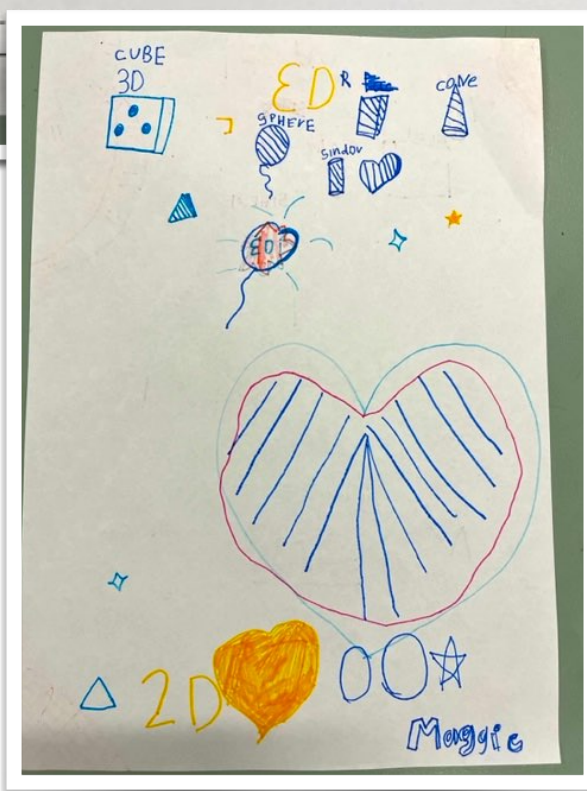
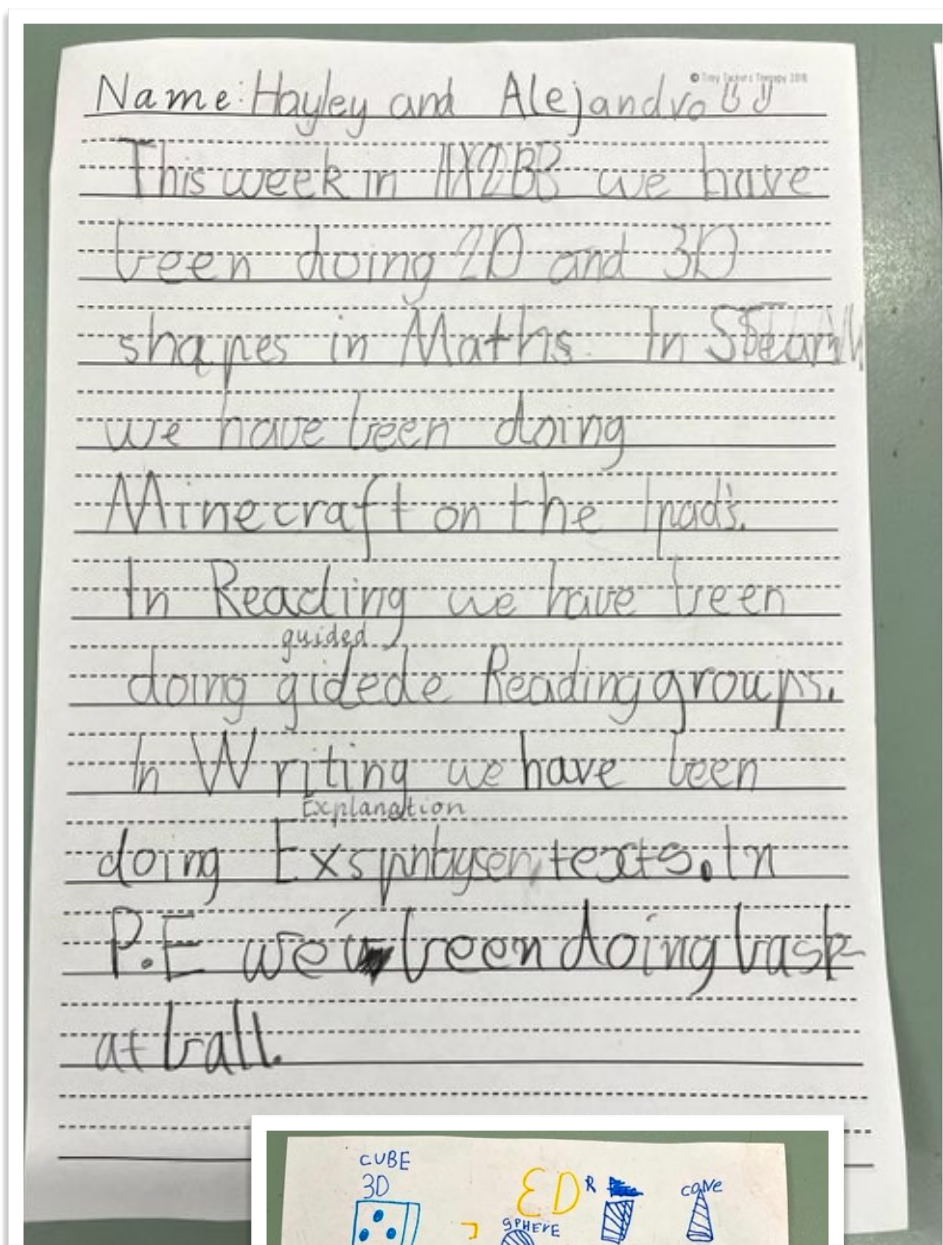
