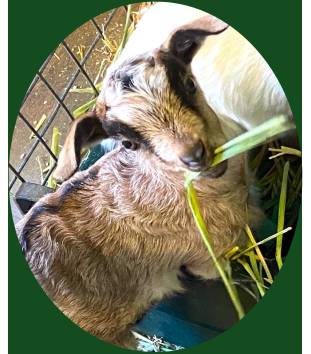


Newsletter
