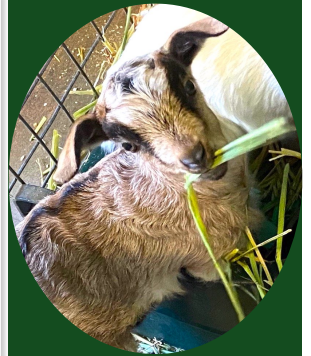


# Carrum Newsletter

**As previously communicated in the newsletter, we will be running four transition sessions ('Up Sessions') for our students in Prep to Grade 5 to assist with transition for 2024.**

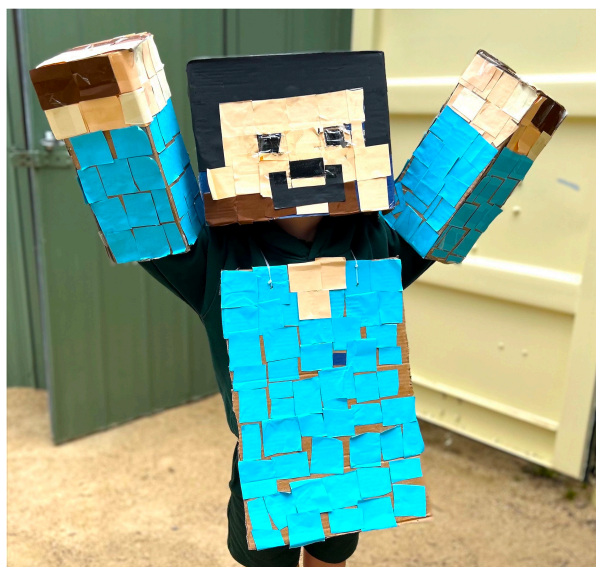
During these sessions our teachers will support all students to best prepare them for the following year and start the process of class allocations for next year.

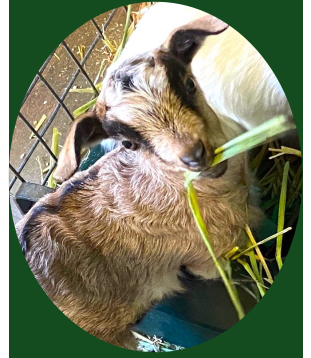
