As previously communicated in the newsletter, we will be running four




transition sessions ('Up Sessions') for our students in Prep to Grade 5 to assist with transition for 2024.



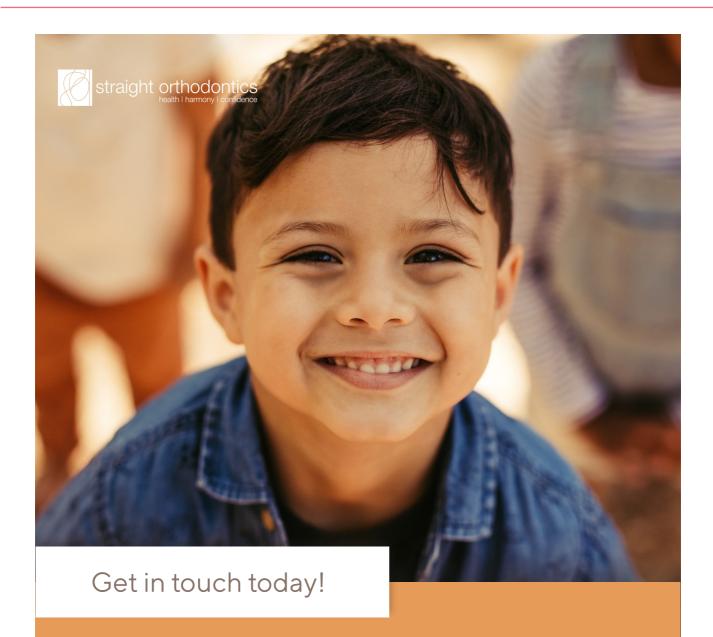
