
Do you know an ADHDer? Is someone in your family an ADHDer? Are you wondering if your child is an ADHDer but you aren't sure?

Whilst statistics vary, approximately 6-10% of Australian kids are ADHDers. Every ADHDer is different and there are 3 types of ADHD so it can be hard to know what the traits are.

There are 3 main categories of ADHD:

- ADHD-Inattentive characterised by differences regulating attention
- ADHD-Hyperactive characterised by impulsive and hyperactive behaviour
- ADHD-Combined characterised by differences regulating attention and hyperactivity/ impulsivity




