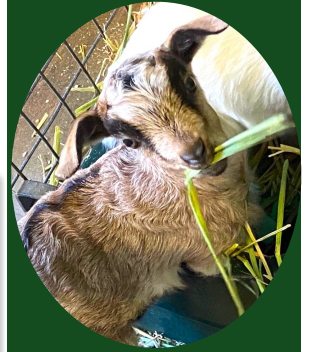

Our staff had a fantastic Professional Learning Day last Friday. We all

participated in the first of four Berry Street Education Model sessions. This session supported staff to develop a deeper understanding of the strategies we use to proactively support students to experience success at school. As you all know the staff at Carrum Primary School

pride themselves on building positive relationships with students and staff to ensure a calm and safe learning environment. We continue to provide education programs that support students to recognise their emotions and behave appropriately while at school. Our Student Wellbeing, Child Safe and Bullying Prevention policies support staff to provide education based on our school values (respect, resilience, collaboration and empathy). These policies are available on our website for families to access as required. Staff and students at Carrum Primary School continue to have high expectations of student behaviour. We have a zero tolerance to bullying and aggressive behaviour and will work together with our families to address these behaviours as required. On these occasions support will be made available for all students, staff and families. I ask that all families read these policies and are aware of the expectations required for all members of the school community.

Over the coming weeks our Grade 3 and 5 students will be preparing for NAPLAN testing. The NAPLAN tests are being conducted from the 13th to 25th March. This testing measures students' performance in Reading, Conventions of Language (Spelling and Grammar), Writing and Numeracy over four tests. 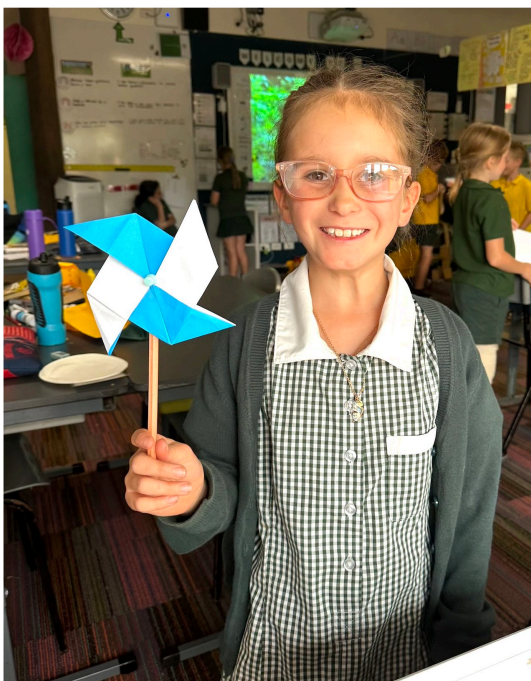

Thank you to all our parents and carers who have been volunteering in the classrooms.

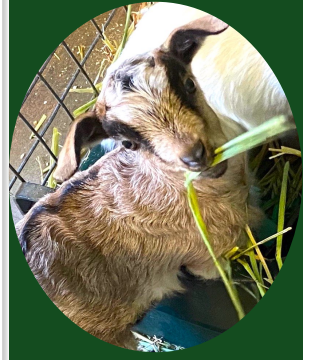
