#### School Attendance is the single most important thing a child can do

**each day.** Research shows that if a child misses school not only does it impact their academic achievement but it also affects how they interact with their peers and their feel of connectedness to school. Please read through the fact sheet below in relation to school attendance and reporting your child's absences.

#### Fact Sheet for parents/carers

If your child is sick or absent, you are required to notify us as soon as possible on the day of absence using one of the following methods:

1. Online: log the absence directly using Compass.

Telephone: the school office (9772 1117) and let the staff know your 2. child's name, class, date of absences and reason.

Email: the school (carrum.ps@education.vic.gov.au) and provide the 3. staff with your child's name, class, date of absences and reason.

Notifying the school of your child's absence either prior to, or on the day that they will be away, helps ensure the safety and wellbeing of children and will fulfil your legal responsibility.

#### Why do I need to notify the school if my child is absent?

Schools need to know when and why a child is absent and you need to know if your child isn't at school.

From the end of Term 2 2018, all Victorian government schools are required to contact parents/carers as soon as practicable on the same day (where possible) of an unexplained student absence. If your child is absent on a particular day and you have not contacted the school to explain why, the absence will be marked as unexplained.

This system also promotes daily school attendance. Going to school every day is the single most important part of your child's education, they learn new things every day - missing school puts them behind.

#### What is your responsibility?

You are legally required to ensure your child attends school every day or you must provide an explanation for their absence. You should let the school know in advance of any upcoming absences or let them know in the morning if your child won't be at school. In order for schools to implement the same day notification requirement, it's essential that you provide the

school with your most up-todate contact details.

Generally one notification will be sent per family. Should there be circumstances that require both parents and carers to be notified, please contact the school to make the necessary arrangements.

### What is the school's responsibility?

The school must notify you of an unexplained absence in relation to your child as soon as practicable on the same day.





Last Day of Term 1 28 March (2.30pm finish)

Schools will let you know either by Compass, phone call or email. If you can't be reached because the school does not have your correct contact details (i.e. changed phone number, email failure notification received etc.), the school will attempt to make contact with any emergency contact/s nominated on your child's file held by the school. Where possible, this contact will be made on the same day of the unexplained absence.

## Where can I learn more about the process for managing student absences?

Our Attendance Policy is located on our school website, which outlines the school's processes and procedures for monitoring, recording and following-up of student absences.

As I have shared in the newsletter this term, our staff continue to implement the Berry Street Education Model to support students with being ready to learn at school. To support students staff are providing Consistent Predictable Routines each day. As a parent I know that this is also important at home in preparing our children for school. Keeping the morning routine consistent helps our children transition from home to school and be ready to learn when they get here. We all know that from

time to time that getting our children ready for school can be a little chaotic. A lovely term that was used during our Berry Street Training was, "we want to bring the children into our calm and not get brought into the chaos." We know



that when there is a lot going on emotions can run high, so please stay calm reach out for support from us as required and we will do our best to support your child in transitioning to school and being ready to learn each day. Throughout the year we will be providing information through the newsletter and parent information session to support you with understanding the ideology of the Berry Street Education Model. Please keep an eye out for this information or speak to your child's classroom teacher if you would like to understand it further.

Looking ahead, tomorrow we have a jam-packed assembly!
