This week year 3 to 6s all went to the Seaford Little Athletics track to do our House athletics. Everyone that went at least had a go in 6 activities which was great to see.

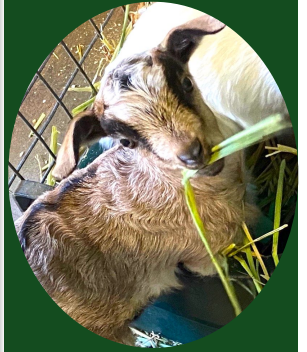

While visiting, experience our interactive STEM Room and busy Science Labs, sample fresh baked goods from our kitchens and be entertained by our Performing Arts students.

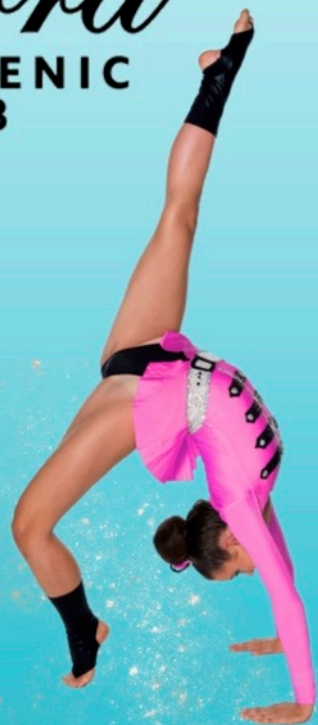
