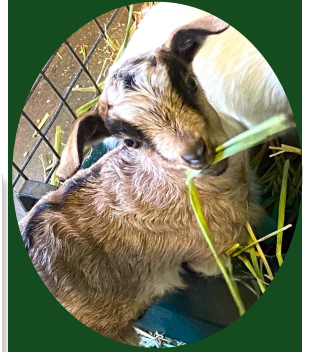


Newsletter

Good luck Sam, we will all be cheering you on!

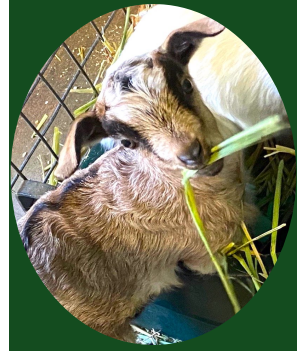
Next Tuesday, our School Captains will be representing Carrum Primary School at the Seaford RSL ANZAC Commemorative Service involving local school students.

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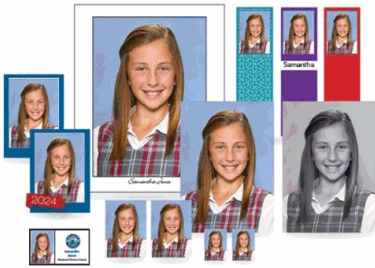
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College Tours

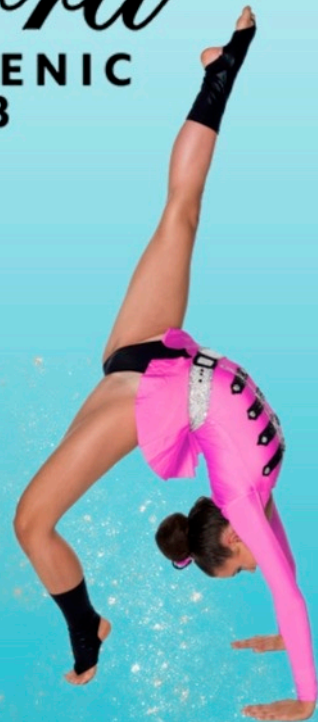


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
