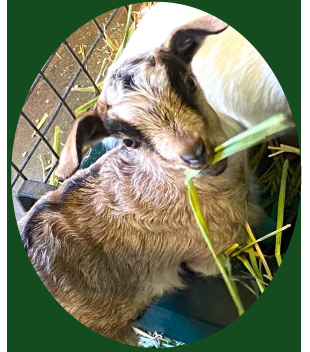


# Newsletter

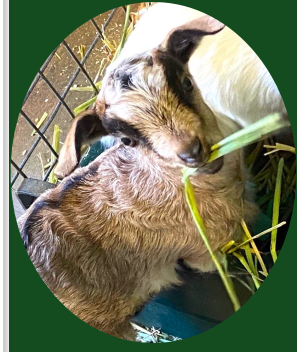

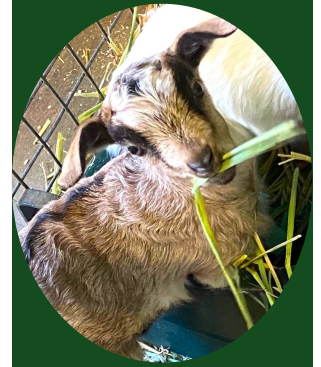
### Mother's Day Stall

*Students who are absent will have the opportunity to attend the stall on Friday 10th May 2024.*

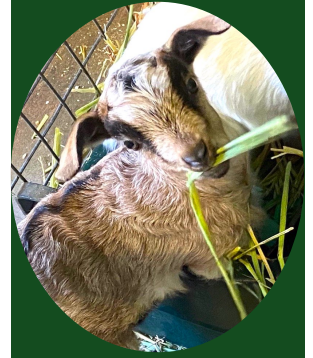
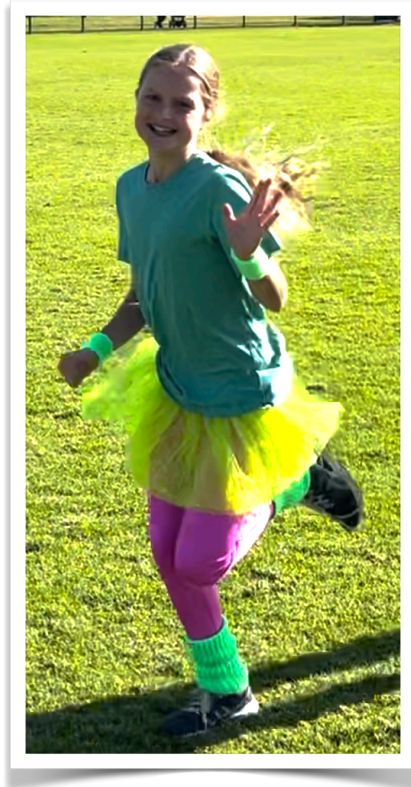

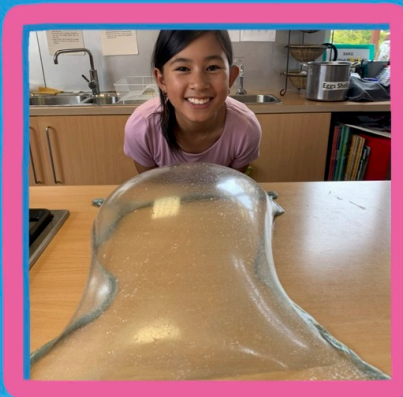
## Make it Messy!

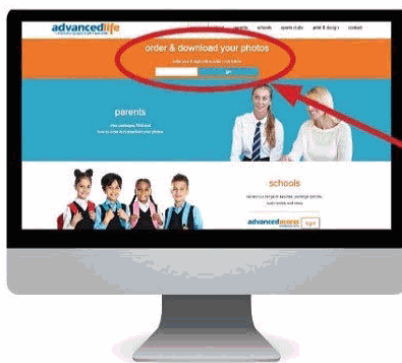

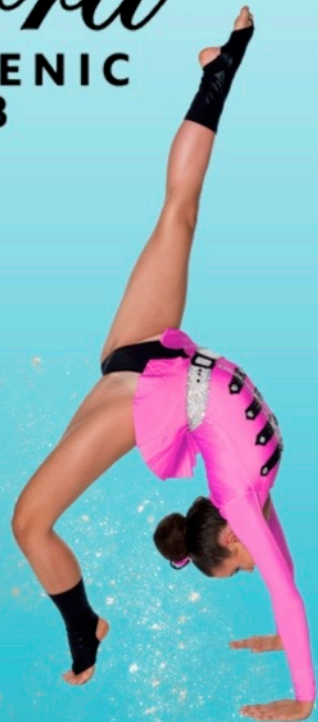
