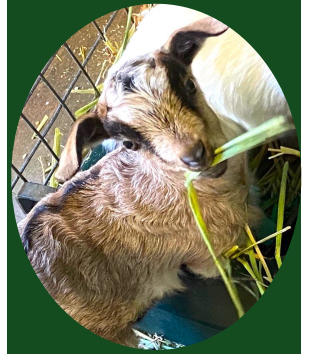
## As we come to the end of Semester 1, we reflect on a fantastic Term 2.

Our staff continue to review our current progress against the school's Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) goals and targets. I am happy to share that there are some really positive areas of improvement this year.

We continue to build capacity in staff relating to trauma informed practices. This has resulted in fantastic feedback from classroom surveys with our Grade 3-6 students. In these results we see a significant improvement in positive responses to classroom behaviour and peer relationships. Over the last two weeks our Grade 4-6 students participated in the Attitudes to School Survey. Similarly, these results reflect the amazing work our teachers and students do to

ensure we have a highly effective learning community.

**This week our Grade 1/2 Students went on an excursion to Ripponlea.** I have heard so many wonderful stories about what life was like in the good old days. Thankfully we don't need to cook on a

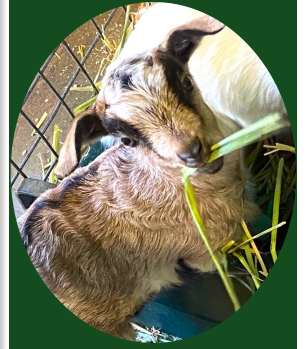

### Our Tutor Learning Initiative and Intervention

**group work continues to support classroom programs.** Mrs Dudley and Ms McManus continue to work with small groups inside and outside of the classroom depending on the activity being completed. These programs support the classroom teachers' program, which continues to be differentiated to support the individual needs of the students. Some of these groups also look at extension and enhancing the students critical thinking skills.

### The Semester 1 reports will be shared via Compass on Monday 24th June.

Teachers have completed personalised reports based on student progress during Terms 1 and 2. Parent Teacher Interviews will be held on **Wednesday 26th June from 1:30-6pm**. Interview booking are now open on Compass. If you are yet to book a time with your child's classroom teacher, please do so. The Interviews are an opportunity for families to discuss the Semester 1 reports in greater detail.

### Finally, the week ends tomorrow with our Grade 5/6 students participating in the Winter Lightning Premiership.

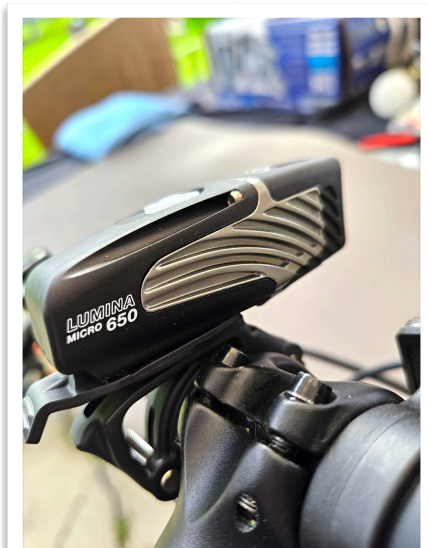

## Holiday Program Important Information!

### What to bring

- A healthy morning tea and lunch
- A labelled drink bottle for water
- Suitable clothing for an active day – closed toe shoes and jacket if wet/cold
- SunSmart hat for Spring and Summer holidays
- Medical Management Plan & Medication if applicable – see below for details

### Don't forget!

- Keep your lunchbox nut-free to keep everyone safe
- Do not include food items that need to be reheated
- Label all items with child's name!
- Bus departure and arrival times are indicative only. For an accurate estimated time of arrival and departure please contact your service directly.

### Personal belongings

Electronic devices, money and other valuables should be left at home. If brought to the service, these items remain the responsibility of the family. TheirCare does not accept responsibility for loss or damage.

### TheirCare provides

- Breakfast and afternoon tea snack
- Sunscreen
- Water to refill bottles

### Child Care Subsidy

Please note that subsidised hours are calculated and allocated by Centrelink on a fortnightly basis. Check Centrelink for eligibility. Each session is calculated using the full service operational hours, not the hours attended by the child.

### Unexpected changes to activities

In the unlikely event that an activity is unable to run, an alternative activity will be provided.

Activities and times are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances such as severe weather or provider availability. If an alternative cannot be sourced we will update your invoice to reflect this.

### Serious stuff!

#### Medical Management Plan & Medication

All children who have been diagnosed with a medical condition including allergies, food/chemical intolerances, anaphylaxis, asthma, epilepsy will need to provide:

- a completed Medical Management Plan with a colour photo
- necessary medication

Please note it is a legal requirement under the Education & Care National Regulations and the Terms and Conditions for booking that these are provided.

In the interests of child safety, care may be refused on the day should the appropriate documentation or medication or medication not be supplied.

### Changes to your booking

Simply log into your account anytime to make the relevant changes or call us between 6:30am – 9:00pm weekdays on 1300 072 410.

### Fees for changes to your booking

More than 5 days	Less than 5 days*	On the day
No Charge	\$10.00	Full Fee

\*Less than 5 days from the start of the booking (120 hours from the start of the session).

When making additional bookings, the \$10.00 fee is eligible for the Child Care Subsidy, which means you may only need to pay the gap, depending on your families' circumstances.

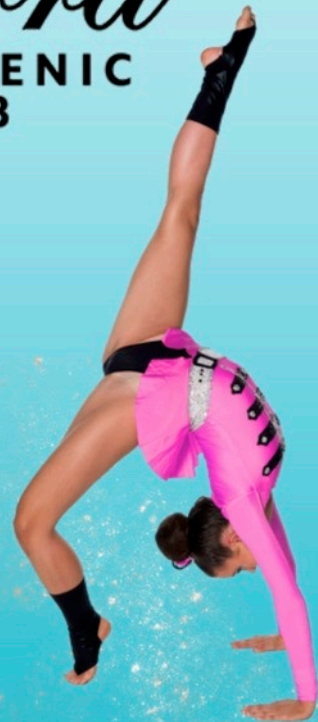
