capacity in staff relating to trauma informed practices. This has resulted in fantastic feedback from classroom surveys with our Grade 3-6 students. In these results we see a significant improvement in positive responses to classroom behaviour and peer relationships. Over the last two weeks our Grade 4-6 students participated in the Attitudes to School Survey. Similarly, these results reflect the amazing work our teachers and students do to



ensure we have a highly effective learning community.

Our Tutor Learning Initiative and Intervention

These programs support the classroom teachers' program, which continues to be differentiated to support the individual needs of the students. Some of these groups also look at extension and enhancing the students critical thinking skills.


