As a team they work so well together at educating all our students. The work they do is very complex and our ES and Teachers continue to provide adjustments, supports and extension tasks to meet the learning needs of the children in their grades. Recently we received the results of our students' **Attitudes to School Survey.** Below are results from

specific focus areas we reflect on as part of our schools Annual Implementation Plan:

School Connectedness- 90% Positive endorsement Stimulating Learning Environment- 98% Positive endorsement Effective Classroom Behaviour- 92% Positive endorsement Managing Bullying- 92% Positive endorsement Self-Regulation and Goal Setting- 96% Positive endorsement

These results show the percentage of students in our Grade 4-6 area who gave positive responses to questions relating to each of these important aspects of our school climate. The results are well above similar and state benchmarks and is a credit to all our students and staff. We are

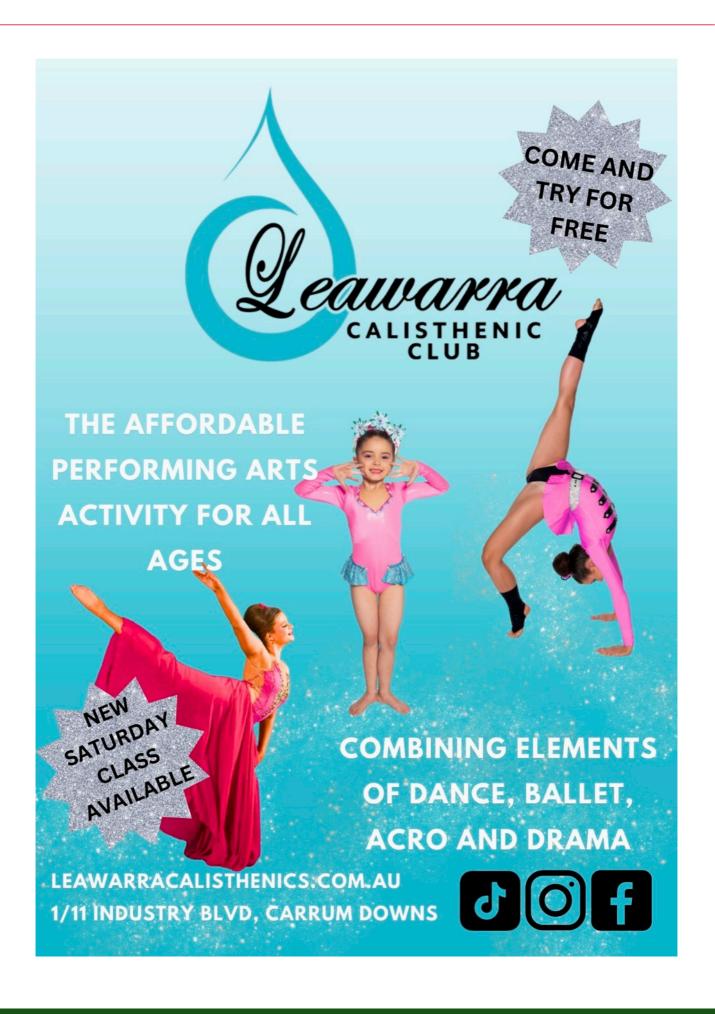
