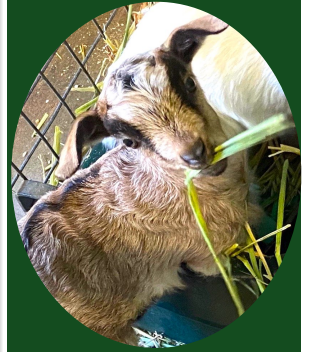


Newsletter

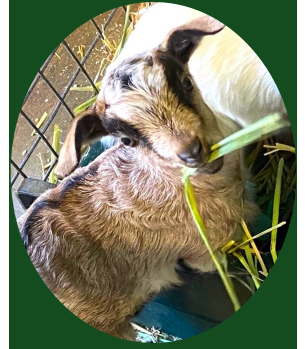


In Mandarin we are learning how to speak Chinese and focusing on the numbers 1-100.

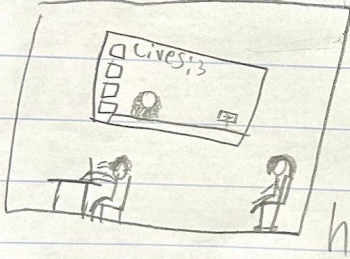


this year we've been learning to develop our understanding of time and for writing we've been learning to write a factual information under the correct sub-headings.

EXPO Week will run from **Monday 29 July to Friday 2 August**,

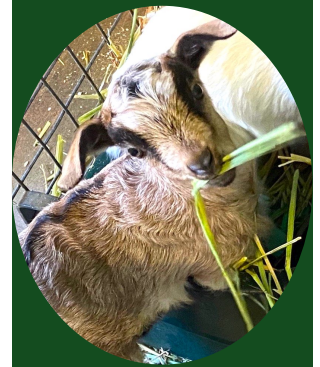
showcasing some of the fantastic learning our students are discovering at Carrum PS. It also gives us an opportunity to build community.

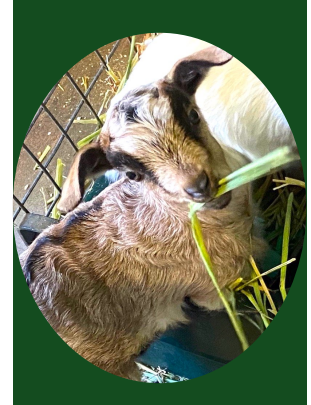
Tuesday 30 July is Book Day.

join in the colourful fun! Our Junior School Council will announce the best costumes at Assembly on Friday 2 August.



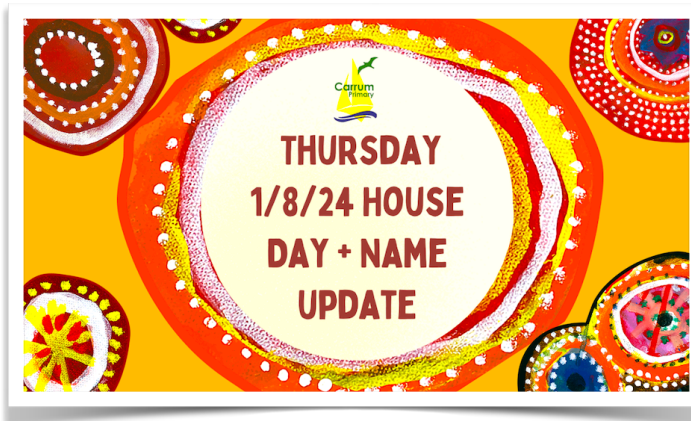
Wednesday 31 July is STEAM Day.

Friday 2 August is Olympics and Disco Day.

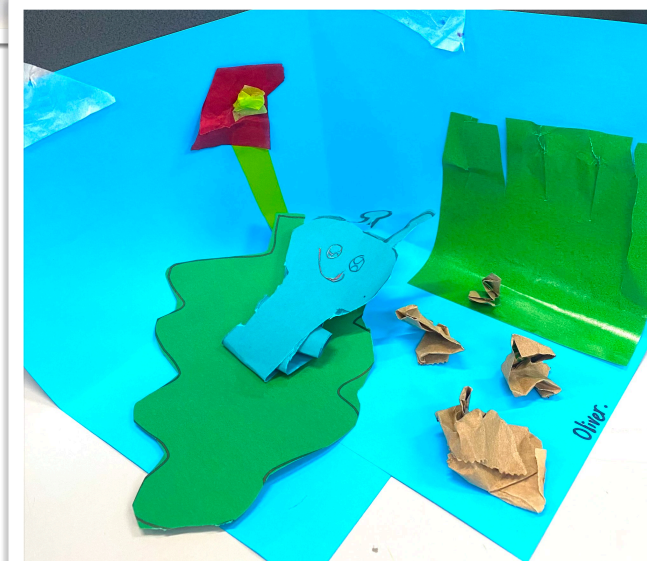
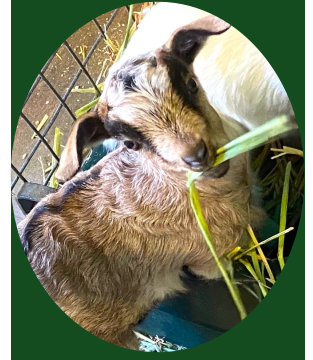
The last day of EXPO Week kicks off with a whole school Olympics Celebration with Multi-Sports Fun. After recess, DJ Tom & DJ Martie will be
